When words are not enough, images and symbols can help tell stories. The ability to tell stories through art can lead to a path of wellness and recovery.

Entry Deadline April 1

Rappahannock Area Community Services Board (RACSB) is currently seeking entries for the Fifteenth Annual "The Art of Recovery" exhibit. The art show features original artwork by adults with mental illness. The show is organized by members of Kenmore Club, RACSB's psychosocial clubhouse for adults with severe and persistent mental illness.

The exhibit will be on display at The PONSHOP Studio and Gallery located at 712 Caroline Street, Fredericksburg.



Fifteenth Annual Art of Recovery Exhibit

The Art of Recovery provides a forum for artists living with mental illness to gain confidence in their abilities, address misconceptions surrounding mental illness, and experience community support.

Eligibility

This exhibition is open to artists with mental illness. There is no fee to enter. There is no limit to the number of entries. Pieces must be **original** and available for sale (include price and dimensions).

Specifications

All work submitted must be **original** artwork, framed appropriately and equipped with a hanging wire on the back for installation. Please refer to hanging and framing instructions for additional guidance.

Drawings, paintings, sculpture, textiles, prints, mixed media, and ceramics will be considered. Artists are encouraged to submit high-quality photographs when not providing the actual work for consideration.

Calendar

All entries must be submitted for consideration by April 1. Artists will be notified of decisions by April 15th. All pieces selected must be delivered to RACSB no later than April 26th. Items not selected will be returned the week of May 1st. The opening reception will be held Friday, May 3rd from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. with a gallery welcome around 6:30 p.m. The initial exhibit at The PONSHP will conclude May 27th.

Agreement

By submitting work for entry, artist agrees to allow representations of work to be shown and reproduced for publicity purposes. Artist assumes liability for damaged or lost pieces. Only original work will be displayed.
