About Art Therapy

Art therapy in a mental health profession setting uses the creative process of art making to improve and enhance the physical, mental, and emotional well-being of individuals of all ages. It is based on the belief that the creative process involved in artistic self-expression helps individuals resolve conflicts and problems, develop interpersonal skills, manage behavior, reduce stress, and increase self-esteem and self-awareness. When words are not enough, images and symbols can help tell stories. The ability to tell stories through art can lead to a path of wellness and recovery.

Eligibility

This exhibition is open to artists with mental illness. There is no fee to enter. There is no limit to the number of entries. Pieces must be **original** and available for sale (include price and dimensions).

Specifications

All work must be original 2d pieces. Textiles will be considered if they are able to be hung on a wall. Artists are encouraged to submit high-quality photographs for consideration. If selected, please send pieces framed appropriately and equipped with a hanging wire on the back for installation. Please refer to hanging and framing instructions for additional guidance.

Calendar

All entries must be submitted for consideration by March 1. Artists will be notified of decisions by April 1st. All pieces selected must be delivered to RACSB no later than April 27th. The celebratory reception will be held 1st Friday May 1 from 5-9 pm.

Agreement

By submitting work for entry, artist agrees to allow representations of work to be shown and reproduced for publicity purposes. Artist assumes liability for damaged or lost pieces. Only original work will be displayed. All pieces must be for sale. Artwork must be picked up by June 6th from the Kenmore Club. Any artwork not retrieved by June 6th, 2026 will become the property of RACSB, Kenmore Club.
